Do you have a favorite Danish band or artist? Yeah, Aqua.



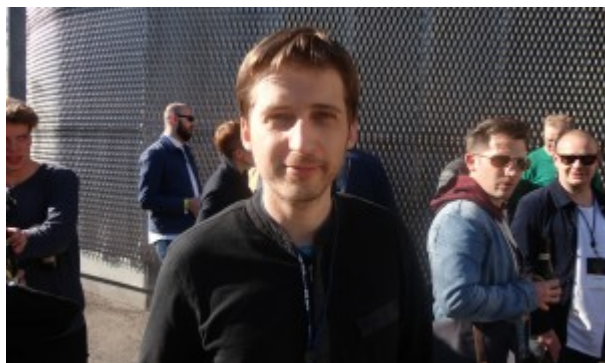
Name: Anne Raun, DK - [Heartbeat](#)

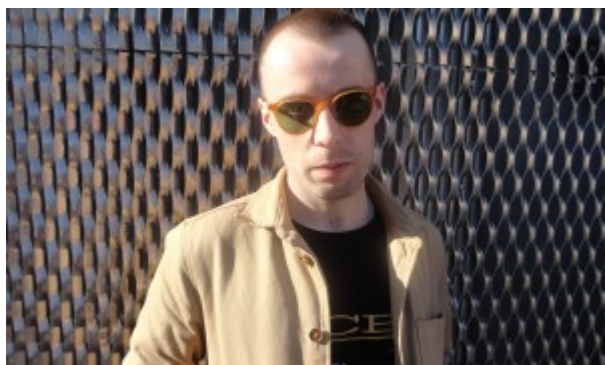
